

MOSQUE MUST GO

■ A MOSQUE being erected illegally on municipal land in Lenasia will be demolished, the Johannesburg Property Company (JPC) said yesterday.

A religious group had leased the vacant land, demarcated as a public open space, to hold open-air services for its congregation.

Their lease had expired in November 2009.

JPC spokesman Brian Mahlangu said that about three weeks ago the group began erecting a structure which was to become a mosque on the land. – Sapa.
